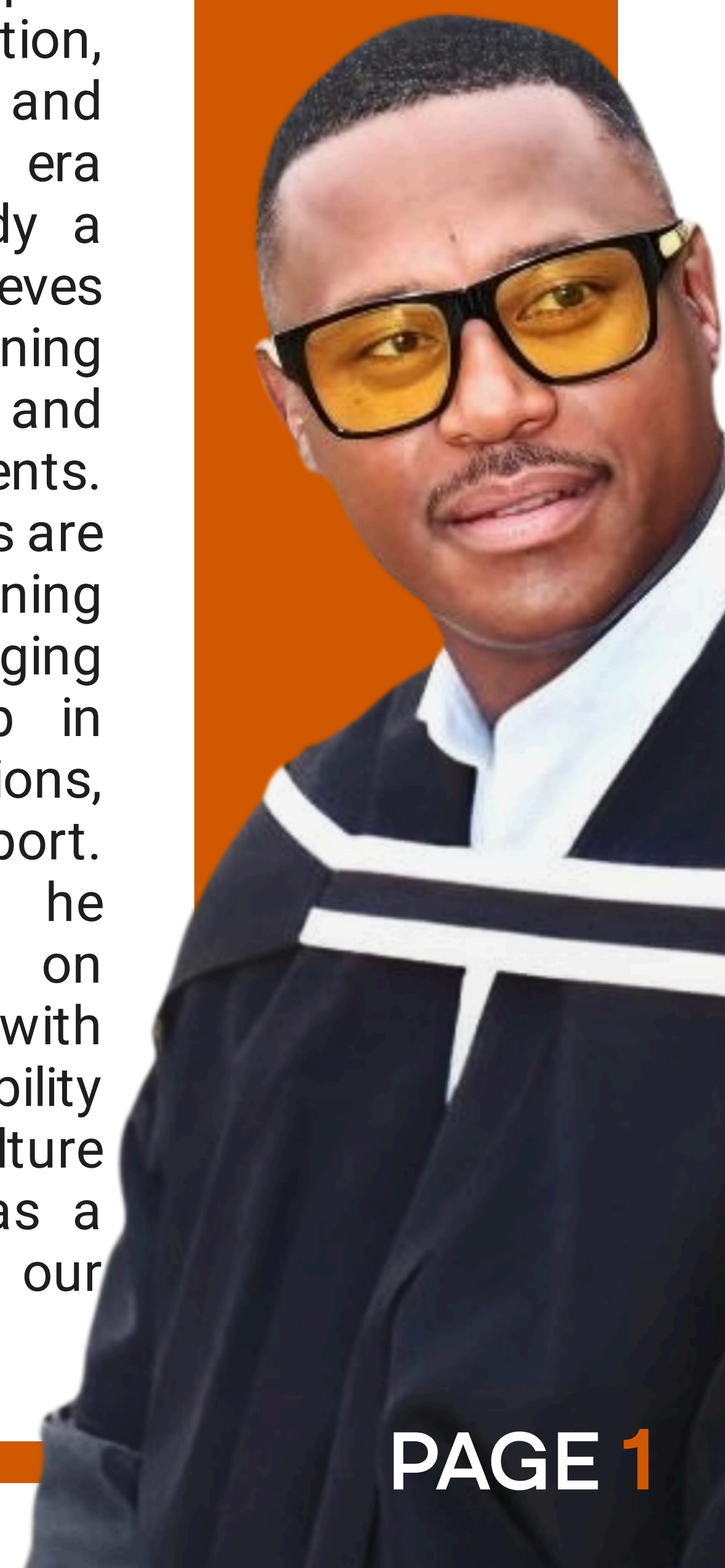
## RAYMOND RANTA

Raymond William Ranta: A Journey Forged in Mining Excellence. Leadership is often described as a trait one is born with, but for Raymond Ranta, it is defined by the actions that uplift others and shape the industry. Born and raised in South Africa, Phokeng and later relocated to Khuma, Raymond William Ranta's journey reflects perseverance, courage, and continuous growth. His early education took place across Jouberton and Vaal Reefs Technical High School, laying the foundation for a career deeply rooted in mining and engineering. He began his professional path in 1995 as an apprentice player-welder with Anglo American at Vaal Reefs in a 26-month program, later learned to develop resilience and adaptability at Tau Lekoa mine during a period of operational restructuring in 1998. Driven to advance his skills, he pursued a National Diploma in Civil Engineering at Cape Peninsula University of Technology in 1999, graduating cum laude. Encouraged by his professor to integrate civil engineering with mining, he completed a Bachelor of Engineering in Mining Engineering with first-class honours at University of Pretoria. Raymond's mining leadership career accelerated at AngloGold Ashanti, where he progressed from Manager in Training to Mine Overseer at Kopanang mine and in the very same year got appointed as Section Manager. For 16 months he was based in the regional office as the technical assistant of the senior vice president. "The period as a technical assistant provided me with exposure to the senior leadership of AngloGold Ashanti including the then CEO Mr. Mark Cutifani and his executive team that shaped my conception of operating at an executive level from a corporate level perspective,"

The key lesson is to use every opportunity, regardless of position, to observe, learn and develop a strategic mindset that prepares one for higher opportunities. In 2014 he returned to operations and gained multi-commodity exposure at Kumba Iron Ore and Samancor Western Chrome Mines before being appointed General Manager of Mponeng mine in 2019, which is the deepest mine in the world. Under his leadership, the mine achieved its first loss-of-life-free year, a historic milestone. In 2020, he led operations at Siguri Gold Mine as the general manager before returning to South Africa in 2022. He currently serves as Mining Executive (Regional General Manager) for Northwest Operations. Complementing his technical leadership, Raymond completed an Executive MBA with University of Cape Town in 2025. Aware of the phrase that all work and no play make jack a dull boy, he finds balance in motorcycling and watching soccer. He draws his strength from the unwavering support of his wife, Jacoline and their two beautiful children, Reabetswe and Reneilwe, who remain a constant source of motivation and inspiration in his journey. When reflecting on the influences that shaped his career, he points to Mr. Billy Mawasha as a pivotal mentor. "He played a guiding role in my life, imparting essential skills and inspiring me to view my career as a journey I could navigate with courage and without fear," His core leadership decisions are among the eight human powers, four have consistently guided his decisions; Agency, the power to choose one's path; Accountability, the ability to own the results of one's actions; Moral Judgement, the capacity to discern right from wrong; and Commitment, the strength to endure when walking away would be easier. The mining journey is shifting towards a future where artificial intelligence increasingly underpins business solutions. Automation, optimisation systems, and predictive analysis will shape the era ahead. As someone who is already a leader in the mining industry, he believes analytical skills are essential for mining engineers to align with AI and optimization system requirements. Opportunities for young professionals are no longer confined to traditional mining roles. Beyond the mine, emerging pathways include entrepreneurship in mining, banking analyst positions, regulatory roles, and technical support. Recalling his first leadership role, he reflects that success depended on valuing people, treating them with humanity, and embedding accountability across the team. "I promoted a culture where everyone, including myself as a leader, owned the outcomes of our actions," he notes.
